Re: Anti-Bullying Week

Anti-Bullying Week 2022 takes place from Monday 14th – Friday 18th November with the theme 'Reach Out'. This year's theme comes from consultations with teachers and pupils, who stressed the importance of empowering everyone to act positively. This way we can work together to counter the harm and hurt that bullying causes.

Next week, the children in Tiger class will learn about anti-bullying. Although the children are not learning explicitly about bullying, they will learn about friendship, acts of kindness and being kind to others.

In the Early Years, anti-bullying is taught through carpet and circle time sessions. The children will be using Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) Jigsaw materials to learn about friendships and celebrating differences. In the continuous provision, the children will have the opportunity to role-play and become special superheroes to save the world with the powers of kindness.

The children can come into school wearing odd socks on Tuesday 15th November to support the campaign.
