Dear Parent/Carer,

A Level 3 weather warning has been issued. There is a 90% probability of severe cold weather/icy conditions/heavy snow between 9am on Monday 6th March and 12midnight on Thursday 9th March in parts of England, including London.

The school will:

- Work with the site team to ensure that external areas are suitably gritted
- Minimise time spent outdoors for pupils and ensure pupils are appropriately dressed for the outdoors

Guidance for families:

Make sure that you stay warm. If going outside, make sure you dress appropriately. If indoors, make sure that you keep your heating to the right temperature; heating your home to at least 18°C in winter poses minimal risk to your health when you are wearing suitable clothing. If there is anyone you know who might be at special risk, for example, an older person living on their own, make sure they know what to do to stay warm and are well stocked with food and medications.
