It has been a wonderful and busy term; we would like to thank all of you for your support and hard work!



For the winter term break we have put together a few activities for you to try with your child if you would like. These activities are linked to the learning we have done throughout this half term.



1) Practice your phonics sounds, green and red words with the children. Look for the words in books or play games where you have to find the words, build the words with lego/duplo or hop to the words.



2) Read a story every day. Share a story together at home, at the park or the library. You can also try reading a book on Oxford Owl using your child's login details, your child will bring this own today.



3) This half term we have been exploring the composition of numbers up to 7. This means that we have looked at different ways numbers are represented (numerial, dots, tallies, word, objects) and how there are numbers within numbers. At home or when out together look for numbers in the environment. Comment on how they have been represented. Ask your child to find a particular number of tree, cars, rocks or street signs. Look for numbers everywhere.



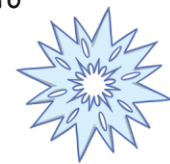
