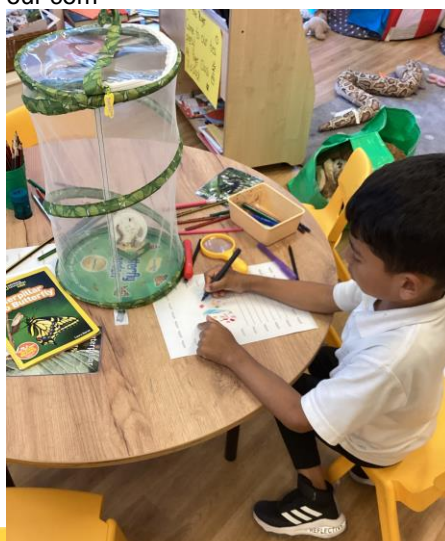
ACTIVITY OF THE WEEK – MEETING THE OFFICERS
