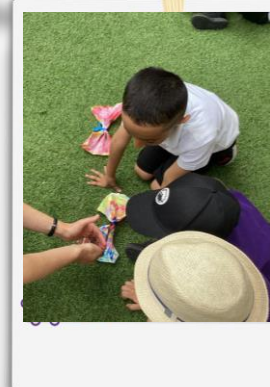

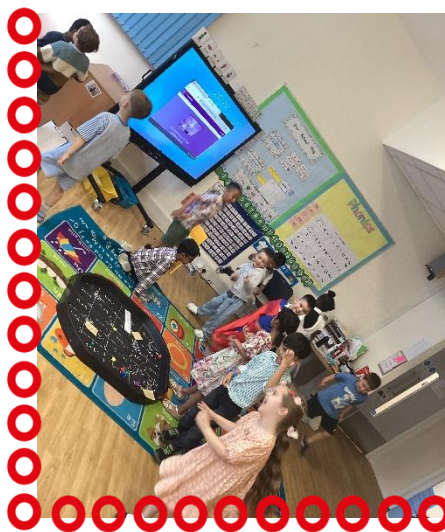
The children also enjoyed sharing their experiences about celebrating Eid al-Adha, talking about the gifts
