<u>ACTIVITY OF THE WEEK –</u> <u>VISITING THE FARM</u>

This week Tiger Class returned to Mudchute Farm to observe the changes between autumn and summer. It was wonderful to see how the children have grown since their first visit to Mudchute Farm. One parent commented on how much the children have developed, how brilliantly they followed instructions and how independent they all were, when eating their lunch, drawing pictures and writing about their trip. They made observations of the animals they saw and all the children enjoyed feeding them lots of delicious farm food.





After the self-guided tour around the farm, the children ate their lunch and discussed which animals were their favourite and explained why. The children then drew pictures of their visit and some also chose to write captions and sentences too. Ram Varenya wrote "I like the duck because it is cute."

This week the children and families met their new Year 1 teacher, Shireena. The children enjoyed learning and playing with Shireena in the afternoon. They are excited to spend more time with her during our Transition Workshop next Wednesday- remember to bring in a shoebox!

UPDATES FROM SARAH JANE

Our school improvement plan includes plenty of opportunities to evaluate the quality of our provision, both internally and externally. We arranged for an external company called Early Excellence to review our provision and curriculum and the consultant spent all of Thursday talking with staff and children, observing practice and reviewing many of our curriculum plans and documentation.

The feedback we received at the end of the day was extremely positive; I will share key findings once we have the written report. One significant observation from the Early Excellence consultant was how Tiger Class demonstrate such amazing characteristics of learning – she commented on how happy and independent the children were. Phonics teaching was highlighted as a real strength and we are looking forward to reading about this in greater depth in the report.

This really has been a fantastic year for Mulberry Wood Wharf Primary and I would like to thank the pupils, staff and parents for building such strong foundations together. It is incredibly exciting to think about the future growth of our school and I look forward to developing our partnership with parents and families further.
