Their focus this week was on their sense of hearing, so there was plenty of noise especially from the farm in the book, 'What the Ladybird heard.' We sang nursery rhymes and replicated the animal noises and also role played the policemen from the story. The children enjoyed making face masks of their favourite animals from the story and were excited to share their final piece with their friends and family. They also created a farm map using grid paper, trying to look at existing maps and replicating their own. On top of that, Blue whale and tiger class have also created wanted posters, so that they could catch the culprit who caused all the animals in the farm to create such noise.

After all the exploring and collecting the children did over the weekend, they came back to school with their bag of autumn goodies. They sat with their peers and discussed what type of autumn delights they had brought in. Eventually, they used the leaves to leaf print and also

paint their own autumn trees, some of which will be showcased in our art exhibition.



As we ended our busy week, we decided to bake a fresh loaf of bread and it went down a treat. The children worked together as a team and shared the roles when following the step by step instructions. We found ourselves talking about how some children like to have their slice of bread in the morning, and others like to make a sandwich with family at home. This activity encouraged conversations between all children and they had great manners and listening skills when talking to their friends.

and poems from Black authors like
Dapo Adeola, Malorie Blackman,
Benjamin Zephaniah and Nathon
Bryon.

In Science, the children have been busy planting cress seeds, naming trees and discovering the autumnal signs around us. Younus felt very proud to share his work on the life of a tree throughout the four seasons. Isaa described his work by explaining 'I know this tree is in autumn because the leaves are orange, and they are falling to the ground'.

At playtime, the children worked as a team and showed fantastic communication skills as well as balancing skills as they created obstacle courses using the wooden construction blocks. It is brilliant to see such creative, kind and fun playtimes.
