We are delighted to share with you the Extracurricular Timetable at Mulberry Wood Wharf for Autumn 2024 and we are happy that we are now able to offer even more clubs!

Our clubs are always very popular and often oversubscribed.

We put a limit on the size of clubs to accommodate adult/child ratio requirements relating to the age group. We pride ourselves on clubs being enriching and we think clubs have more of an impact when there is a small group of around 15 pupils. If the clubs become oversubscribed, we will ensure there is a fair allocation of places in the clubs on offer. We aim to give each child at least 2 clubs.

There is a small charge for some classes where we use an external company, please check the timetable on how to pay via parent pay/ Vantage education. If your child is in receipt of pupil premium, the school will pay class fees, please speak with Sarah Jane.

To book the school-led sessions please complete the form attached on Ping. If your child is given a place in a school-led club, this place will be for half term. If your child misses the club for two sessions, this place will be allocated to another child (unless there are special circumstances).

We appreciate your feedback and if there are any extracurricular clubs you would like us to offer in the future, please let the admin team know. We will do our best to accommodate the children's interests.

**Extracurricular Clubs will commence the week beginning the 16th of September 2024.**

**Music/ Instruments Club** – Children will learn pace and rhythm, developing their technical control, notation and communication skills, and develop creativity as they learn to express themselves through music.

**Intro to Spanish Club** – Enable students to learn about the Spanish language, culture, and history through food, arts, and entertainment.

**Latin Dance** – Latin dancing is known for being a versatile and inspiring form of movement to Latin music.

**Multisport** – A trained coach will support children to develop their sports skills as well as their spatial awareness and team skills. Building up children's stem knowledge and overview.

**Robotics Club** - structured program that introduces children to the world of robotics through hands-on activities and collaborative projects.

**Arts and Crafts Club** - a combination of drawing, painting, box modelling and sewing, tapping into the children's creative skills. The club will develop skills and work on mini projects.

**Jewellery Making** – getting creative juices flowing that teach various jewellery making techniques.

**Contemporary Dance** - Contemporary Club is all about **fun!** Children can come along to show off and practice their favourite moves and learn routines to popular music.

**80's Zumba** - kid-friendly routines based on original Zumba choreography through games, activities and cultural exploration.

**Board Game Club** – a place to learn strategic play, resilience, turn-taking, sustained concentration and the understanding the concept of winning and losing in a safe space – as well as having lots of fun. We will use large scale traditional board games.

**Choir Club** - a safe space for children to express themselves through performance and singing. Songs will develop children's understanding of tone, pitch, volume and beats. They will also learn how they can move their body freely to music.

**STEM Club**- an introduction to coding: children will develop their engineering and coding skills through play-based learning using resources such as Lego, marble runs and kinetic sand.

**Painting Club** - enable children to experience and experiment with a variety of different textures and techniques.

**Street Dance** - mixture of commercial street dance, hip-hop and general techniques that help enhance coordination and rhythm.
